## RULES & REGULATIONS

### INTRODUCTION

The 27<sup>th</sup> edition of the Chinese Montreal Open is a Tenpin Bowling Tournament open to Chinese bowlers from Ontario, Quebec and Western Canada. The main objective is to promote relationships and togetherness among Chinese bowlers from Eastern and Western Canada through the sport of tenpin bowling.

### SCHEDULES

Qualifying Round:	Master & Open Division – 9 a.m. Saturday, September 5 <sup>th</sup> 2009 Graded Division – 2 p.m. Saturday, September 5 <sup>th</sup> 2009
Second Round & Semi-Final Round:	All divisions – 10 a.m. Sunday, September 6 <sup>th</sup> 2009
Final Round:	All divisions – 45 minutes after completion of Semi-Final Round.

### FORMAT

#### 1. MASTER DIVISION (A) – SINGLES

Scratch basis. Open to bowlers of all averages.

Qualifying Round (Day 1): Bowlers will bowl 10 games across 20 lanes. The 12 bowlers with the highest total pinfall will advance to the Second Round (Day 2). Points will not carry over to the next day. Tie breaker: 1 game, highest score will advance.

Second Round (Day 2): Qualified bowlers will bowl 6 games. The 8 bowlers with the highest total pinfall will advance to the Semi-Final Round. Tie breaker: 1 game, highest score will advance.

Semi-Final Round: Match play position round. Position 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, 3 vs. 6 & 4 vs. 5. The 4 match play winners will advance to 2<sup>nd</sup> Semi-Final Round. Tie breaker: 2-frame roll-off.

Final Round: Match play position round. Positions determined by Second Round results. Position 1 vs. 4 & 2 vs. 3. The 2 match play winners will advance to bowl for Championship title. Tie breaker: 2-frame roll-off.

## 2. OPEN DIVISION (B) – SINGLES

Scratch basis. Open to bowlers with an average of 205 and under. Same format as Master Division (A) – Singles.

## 3. GRADED DIVISION (C) – SINGLES

Handicap basis. Open to bowlers with an average of 199 and under.

Qualifying Round (Day 1): Bowlers will bowl 8 games across 16 lanes. The 12 bowlers with the highest total pinfall will advance to the Second Round (Day 2). Points will not carry over to the next day. Tie breaker: 1 game, highest score will advance.

Second Round (Day 2): Qualified bowlers will bowl 5 games. The 8 bowlers with the highest total pinfall will advance to the Semi-Final Round. Tie breaker: 1 game, highest score will advance.

Semi-Final Round: Match play position round. Position 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, 3 vs. 6 & 4 vs. 5. The 4 match play winners will advance to 2<sup>nd</sup> Semi-Final Round. Tie breaker: 2-frame roll-off.

Final Round: Match play position round. Positions determined Second Round results. Position 1 vs. 4 & 2 vs. 3. The 2 match play winners will advance to bowl for Championship title. Tie breaker: 2-frame roll-off.

The Tournament Directors reserve the right to accept or reject any entry and will decide on all questions and disputes that may arise in the tournament. All decisions made by the Directors regarding the prizes will be considered final as published.

## ELIGIBILITY

Open to all Chinese Canadian bowlers from T.C.B.C. & C.C.B.A. of Toronto, O.C.B. from Ottawa, NACBT from Vancouver, C.C.B. from Calgary and M.C.B.A. from Montreal.

## AVERAGE (Graded Division Only)

Average is based on the final averages of 2008/2009 seasons (CTF/ABC/WIBC sanctioned). \*\*Must have a minimum of 36 games played\*\*

## HANDICAP (Graded Division Only)

80% of 200 minus average  
Maximum per game – Men/20 pins, Ladies/30 pins

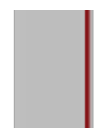

## REGISTRATION

All bowlers must register at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time of each round of the tournament. Failure to do so will result in disqualification and the spot will be given to alternate players.

## EQUIPMENT AND I.D. VERIFICATION

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to check all I.D. and/or refuse entries of bowlers that are not eligible to participate in this tournament. The Committee has the right to check and weigh the balls used by bowlers in this tournament. Balls that violate the specifications within CTF/ABC/WIBC rules will result in disqualification.

## RULES

This tournament is not sanctioned by CTF/ABC/WIBC, however, for rules not mentioned above, their rule books will be used to govern this tournament.

## AVERAGE RE-RATES (Graded Division Only)

All re-rated averages must be reported to the Tournament Directors before bowling. Failure to report this information will result in disqualification.

## AVERAGE ADJUSTMENTS (Graded Division Only)

The Tournament Directors reserve the right to adjust any average for fairness and will notify the bowler of the adjusted average before he/she participates. Such adjustments will be based on our past performance records and other pertinent facts.

## MONTREAL CHINESE OPEN DOUBLES TOURNAMENT

Sunday, September 6<sup>th</sup> 2009 – 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Entry fee:

- \$50 for the main team
- \$20 for each combined pairing

The team's handicap will be determined by the sum of the individual handicap of each pairing.

Individual handicap will be based on 80% of 200 minus average.

Maximum handicap (Man/20 pins, Woman/30 pins)

Examples maximum handicap:

- 40 for a team of man-man.
- 50 for a team of woman-man.
- 60 for a team of woman-woman.

3 games per bowler (6 games per team)
